

## School Improvement Priorities 2017-2018

### Target 1 - Literacy

#### Priorities:

- To further develop the ability of pupils to read fluently and with deeper understanding.
- To increase the engagement of reading between home and school.
- To further develop handwriting and presentation skills.
- To continue to develop extended writing skills.

### Target 2 – Numeracy

#### Priorities:

- To improve pupils' ability to successfully approach procedural and reasoning maths problems across the school.
- To ensure provision for the teaching of numeracy skills reflects analysis of data including National Numeracy Tests.
- Increase engagement in mathematics between home and school.

### Target 3 - Science
