Dear Parents/Carers,

At our recent PTA AGM, we discussed the immense support provided to the school by the very kind generosity of parents and friends of Sully Primary School. As you will know, the financial situation of our school is a very delicate one and so we rely upon accessing grants, bursaries and donations to allow us to provide the best educational experiences for our children.

This year, the PTA raised a staggering £14000. Much of this money has already been utilised by the school with the remaining funds being used to purchase additional iPads and Chromebooks for our pupils.

Moving forward, I would like to develop the school hall to make it a more pleasant environment for our pupils. We use the hall for all manner of events ranging from performances, assemblies, lessons and lunchtimes, however, we believe the area needs to be improved. Initially we would like to investigate a system to improve the hall's acoustics and reduce the noise level.

This will be a significant financial investment and therefore the PTA have agreed to help us raise funds to allow us to improve the hall. Over the next few months or even years, all funds raised by the PTA will be put towards making this project a success. You will see during the many events organised by the PTA a mobile 'fundraising thermometer' which will display how much has been raised towards an overall target.

I hope this letter is clear in its explanation and look forward to families and friends of Sully Primary School continuing to work together to help us improve our school.
