# Welcome Packs

- When your child starts Nursery we will send you an admission pack containing a range of information forms. These include:
  - **Nursery Booklet** - with specific information about the Nursery
  - **Data** - specific information about your child including date of birth, address, contact numbers etc
  - **Educational Visits** - giving permission for the Nursery staff to take the children on local visits
  - **Permissions** - giving us permission to use photos of your child on eg Twitter and for your child to access online learning platforms
  - **Information (pupil)** - personal information about your child eg their likes/dislikes etc





# The Foundation Phase-what is it?

- Statutory curriculum for 3-7 year olds in Wales from Nursery to Year 2
- Skills based
- Learning through play – structured/spontaneous activities
- Hands-on, experiential learning
- Focused tasks, continuous/enhanced provision, child-initiated
- Indoor and outdoor learning every day

# Information

- **Session times** are 9.15am-11.45am and 1pm-3.30pm
- **Drop off and pick-up points**-included in the accompanying letter
- **Clothes** to wear-comfortable clothes that the children are able to put on, pull down etc independently
- **Snack**-please bring your own snack (fruit)
- **Home reading** - pupils are welcome to take books home from the Nursery
- **Outdoor equipment** – please discourage older pupils from using outdoor equipment when collecting Nursery pupils



- **Homework** - pupils will be set homework tasks via the weekly newsletter or via Seesaw (the online learning platform used by Nursery)
- **PE** - the children will take part in PE related activities at least once per week. Please make sure the children are suitably dressed for these activities
- **Absences**-please let the school know if your child is not going to be in school
- **Medical appointments**- please let the school know if your child has a medical appointment which means they will not be attending Nursery
- **Medicine**-medicine can be administered by admin staff-form needs to be completed to give permission
- **Parent – teacher consultations**-usually two during the year but these might need to be by telephone or virtually
- **Contact details**-please keep contact details updated so that we can get hold of you quickly if needed
- **Start dates and times**-we operate a staggered start date and time approach to starting Nursery. Details included in accompanying letter
- **Independence**-please help your child to learn how to put on coats, use the toilet, use a spoon, share etc
