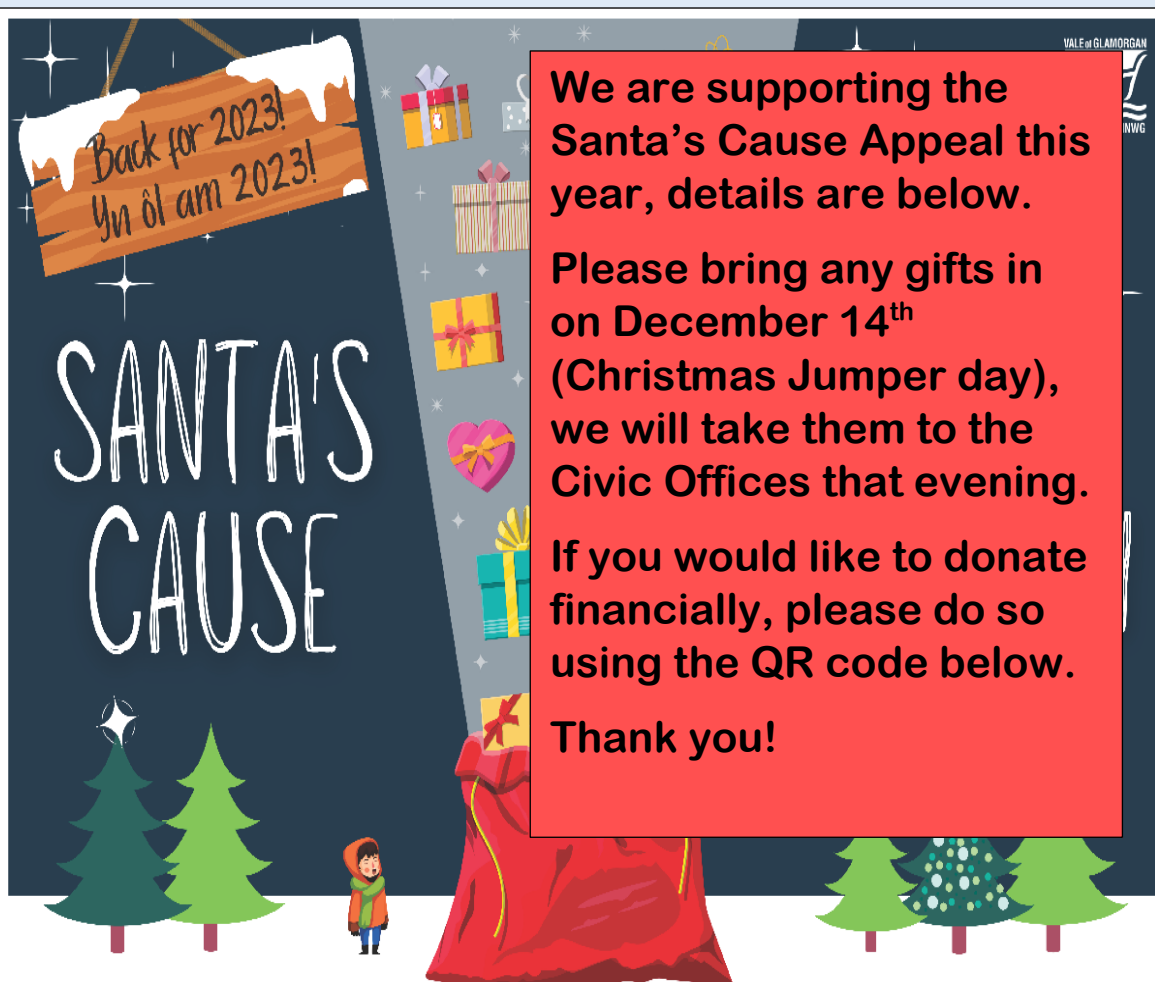

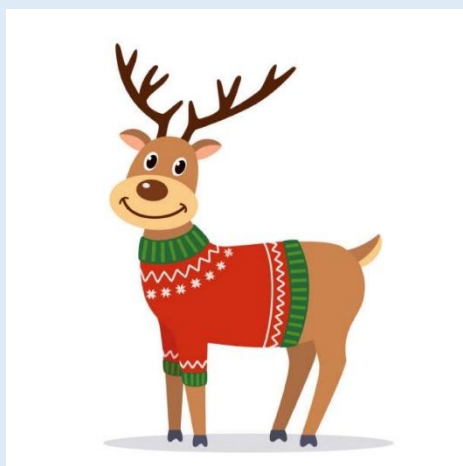

Highlights of this week...

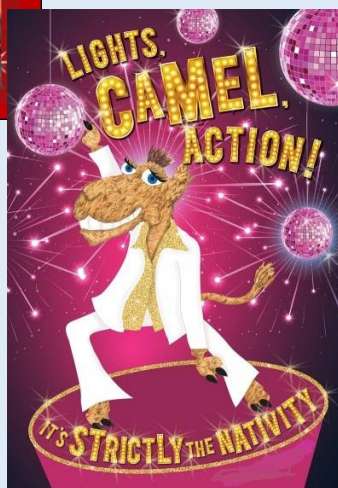


Nursery have had a busy week finding out about Christmas traditions. They have been busy making their Christmas cards and tree decorations!

For Years 1 to 3, what else could their highlight of the week possibly be...?

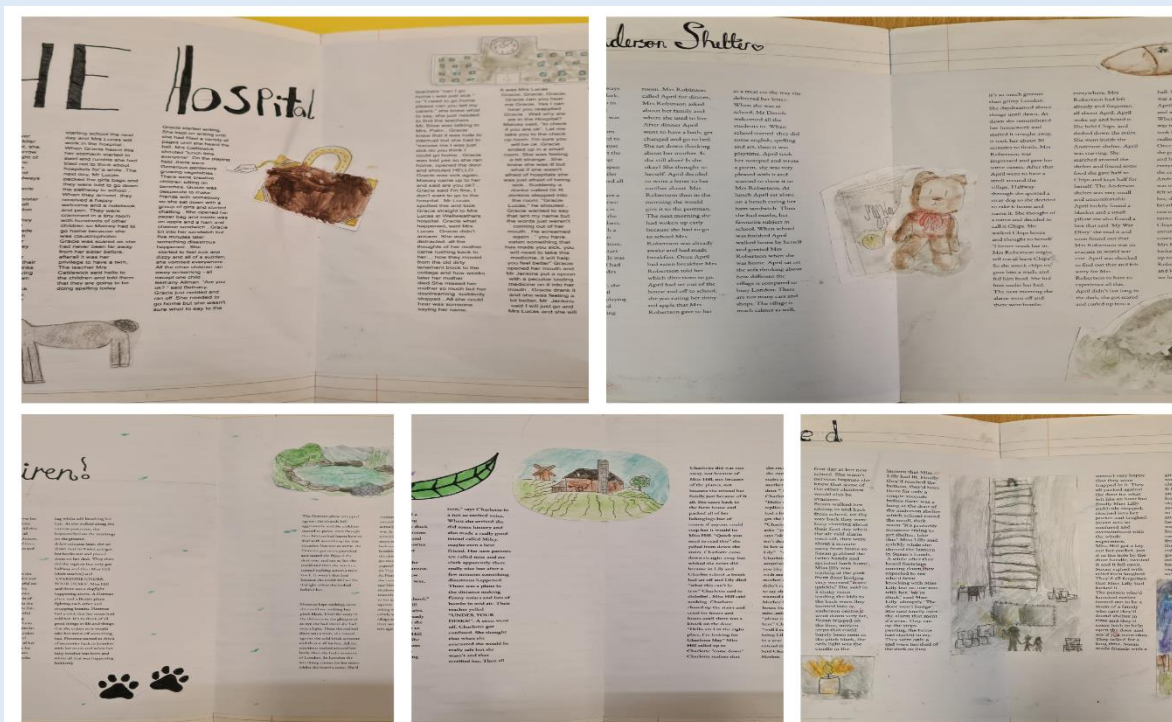




Y4 have been researching the best way to spread news in 2023. They have created questionnaires, made an excel chart of the data collected and analysed the results.
