Traffic Routes

Some time ago discussions were held with the police, the crossing patrol and local councillors about traffic problems outside the school both before and after school. It was decided to ask parents to operate a one-way system in an attempt to minimise the danger to the children.

Parents are asked to drive down Burnham Avenue towards the school, along Smithies Avenue and to turn then into either Weston Avenue or Clevedon Avenue before entering South Road. Neighbouring residents have also been asked to co-operate with this scheme from 8.45am until 9.15am and 3.15pm until 3.45pm.


Complaints have been received from local residents who live in Smithies Avenue or Burnham Avenue regarding parents who park their cars across drives whilst bringing or collecting their children. Please ensure that you do not cause an obstruction.

In addition complaints have been received from residents in Minehead Avenue not only about parents who park across their drives and on the grass verge, but also expressing concern about drivers who put children's lives in danger by undertaking three-point turns in the road by the gate. It would be safer if parents continued around Minehead Avenue in a complete circuit.
