The Nursery children have been exploring transient art. They have used natural resources from around the nursery to make these pictures.

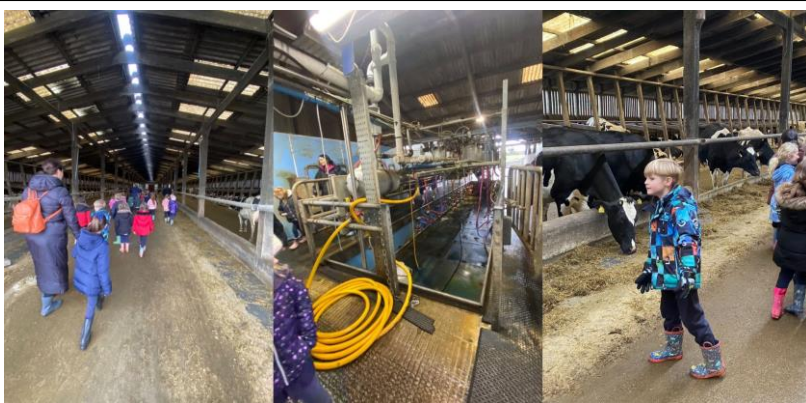

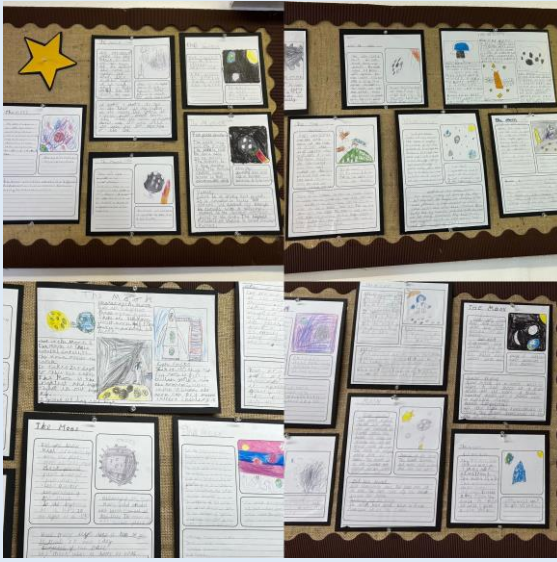


Years 1 and 2 really enjoyed their days at the dairy farm learning about where our school milk comes from!



Ty Tanglowyst Dairy Farm

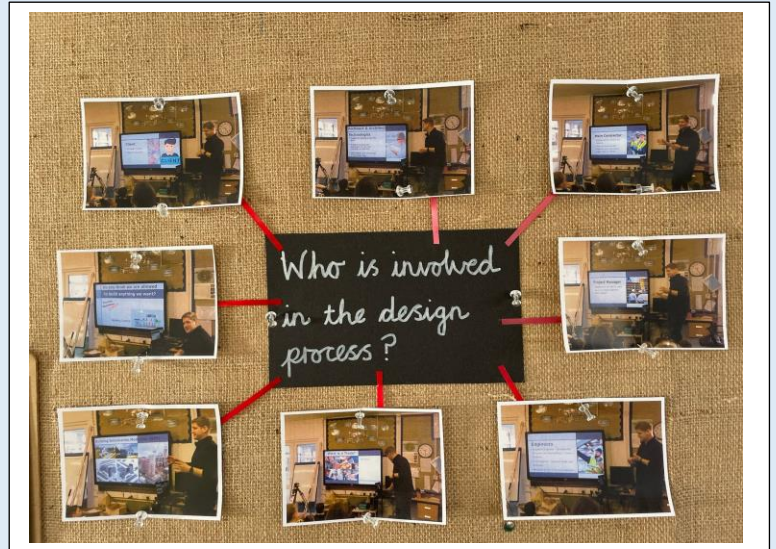




Year 3 have enjoyed using their research skills to find out about the Moon. This week they have used their research to plan and create some fantastic fact files about the Moon
